

Nunavut Arctic College Tuition Fee

POLICY

Tuition Fees for all courses are payable to Nunavut Arctic College. Students who register at Nunavut Arctic College are subject to these fees.

PRINCIPLES

1. Nunavut Arctic College recognizes that the charging of a tuition fee is necessary in order to support the delivery of programs, courses and other activities.
2. The College recognizes that additional fees are necessary to support program delivery and Nunavut Arctic College services.

PROCEDURES

1. The tuition fee is recommended by the Board of Governors in consultation with the President.
2. Tuition fees are approved by the Minister Responsible for Nunavut Arctic College.
3. Tuition Fees are to be published bi-annually in the Nunavut Arctic College Calendar, and on the NAC web-site and are subject to change.
4. Where a student has any questions or concerns regarding financial matters s/he should be referred to Student Services.
5. Nunavut Arctic College staff are eligible for reduced tuition as outlined in Policy C.13.
6. Senior Citizens enrolling on a part-time basis are eligible free tuition as outlined in Policy C.12
