

Nunavut Arctic College Campus Honour Roll

POLICY

An Honour Roll will be established annually for each Nunavut Arctic College Campus and the names displayed in a prominent location at the Campus.

PRINCIPLES

1. The Board of Governors recognizes the value of acknowledging exceptional achievement by the students of Nunavut Arctic College at each Campus.
2. Exemplary academic achievement shall be recognized as a means of contributing to the traditional excellence of the College

PROCEDURES

1. The Honour Roll will recognize the following:
 - Academic excellence
 - Merit

Academic Excellence

- a. The Honour Roll will recognize:
 - i] The top graduates in each Program, at the time of Convocation, as defined by an exemplary average over the duration of the program.
 - ii] The top students in Diploma programs, as defined by an exemplary average, upon successful completion of the first year of the Program.
- b. Students must have maintained an average of eighty percent (80%) or better and no final grade below sixty (60) percent in any program requirement.
- c. The Registrar or designate shall verify the cumulative average of all courses taken by all graduates, and those students who have successfully completed the first year of a Diploma program.

Merit

- d. The Honour Roll may recognize one student annually in each Program who has demonstrated ongoing exemplary behaviour while completing a program.

- e. To be eligible for consideration the student must have displayed one or more of the following: significant academic improvement, leadership, and/or community service.
 - f. The Dean or designate upon recommendation will determine which, if any, students receive this award in each Program.
2. The Dean or designate shall submit to the President the completed list of successful candidates for each Campus Honour Roll.
 3. The Chairperson of the Board of Governors shall prepare and send to the Dean a letter of recognition to be presented to each successful honoree at convocation.
