Nunavut Arctic College Solicitation of Projects from Outside the College

DEFINITION

A project is defined as a learning activity directly related to an approved curriculum and is usually capital in nature.

POLICY

Nunavut Arctic College will therefore provide for the acquisition of projects from outside the College.

PRINCIPLES

1. Nunavut Arctic College recognizes that the curricula in some training programs depend to some degree on training projects.
2. Priority of participation in the project will be given to students first; seniors/elders; and then the general public.

PROCEDURE

1. Project(s) required by a class will be identified by the instructors to the Program manager who will be responsible to coordinate the availability of a suitable project.
2. The acquisition and cost of all materials will be the responsibility of the party for whom the project is being completed.
3. Nunavut Arctic College provides no guarantee of work completed in whole or in part and assumes no liability for loss or damage resulting from fire, theft, etc.
4. A work order must be signed by the project owner.
